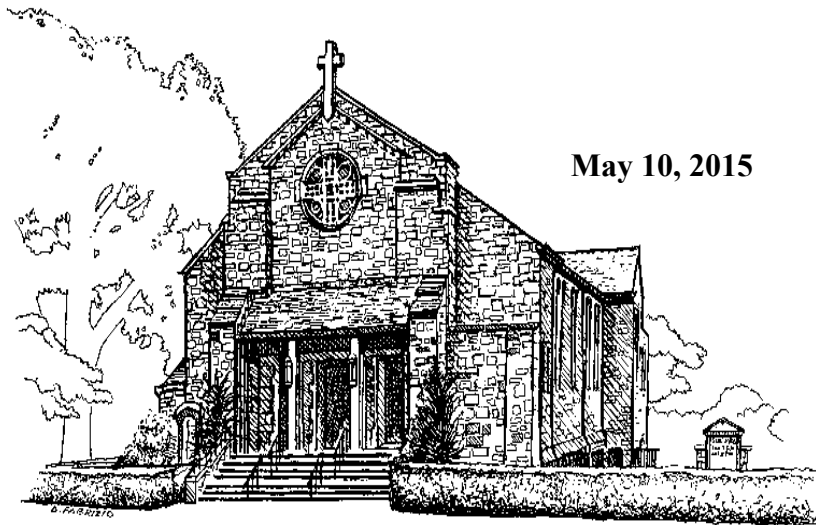

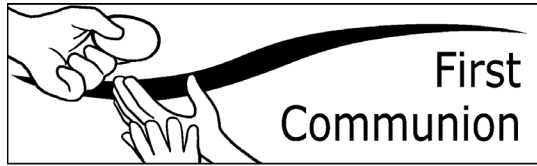

Should lectors read historical notes with the readings?

My parish lectors have started reading historical notes before each of the first two readings. I was taught that the readings are supposed to speak to us in the here and now. What is correct.?

When I enter a large discount store and see a greeter who can give me direction, I feel more secure. A little bit of information saves me a lot of time and walking.

The Preamble of the General Introduction to the Lectionary from the Sacred Congregation for the Sacraments and Divine Worship allows brief introductions before the readings (chapter II, paragraph 15). A brief commentary can put the readings into historical context and connect them with present-day situations. They can help us understand better what the Lord was trying to communicate in the first place and what we need to perceive today.

Of course, if your lectors are putting ideology or personal opinion into it, the purpose of the introduction is defeated. Therefore, if you feel someone is pushing a personal agenda, talk about it privately with your pastor.
